Southern West Virginians for Coal will be holding a press conference on Monday

Beckley, WV - Southern West Virginians for Coal will be holding a Press Conference on Monday, June 29, 2009 at 10:30 AM on the front parking lot of The Beckley/Raleigh County Convention Center, formerly The Armory. (This media event will be moved into the Convention Center's lobby in case of inclement weather.)

According to Tim Booth, media spokesperson for the bipartisan group from West Virginia's southern coal producing counties, "The purpose of the conference is to introduce ourselves to and make ourselves available to Southern West Virginia's media outlets and to lay out an aggressive summer public awareness campaign."

The main focus of the press conference will be to provide additional information about the Save Coal: Say No to Cap and Trade Rally on July 18th that is also being supported by the West Virginia Conservative Foundation.

Following brief remarks, there will be time set aside for a Q&A session from members of the Press.

Southern West Virginians for coal is an all volunteer group of concerned citizens who have organized to help promote the coal industry and to try and save coal related jobs in southern West Virginia.
