

Mollohan, Rahall, Byrd and Rockefeller in lock step with Obama

The deficit will increase \$1,500,000,000,000

CHARLESTON, WV - AUGUST 25, 2009 - Today the White House budget chief Peter Orszag announced that unemployment will pass 10% and the deficit will increase \$1,500,000,000,000. The announcement means that the first two full years in the Obama administration are also the first two years of more than trillion dollar deficits in US history. The White House also admitted the recession is worse than they expected today, something West Virginians already know first hand.
